**Jean Houston** was born on 10 May 1937, is an American author involved in the “Human Potential Movement.” Along with her husband, Robert Masters, she co-founded The Foundation for Mind Research. Houston taught at Marymount College, Tarrytown from 1965 to 1972. She was a lecturer at Hunter College for less than a year in 1961. Her interest in anthropology brought about a close association with Margaret Mead, who lived with Houston and Masters for several years before her death in 1978. In 1982, Houston began teaching a seminar based on the concept of “the ancient mystery schools.”
