Barack Hussein Obama II was born on 04 August 1961, is an American attorney and politician who served as the 44th President of the United States from 2009 to 2017. A member of the Democratic Party, he was the first African American to be elected to the presidency. After graduating, he became a civil rights attorney and an academic, teaching constitutional law at the University of Chicago Law School from 1992 to 2004. He served as a senator from Illinois from 2005 to 2008. In 2008, he was nominated for president a year after his campaign began and after a close primary campaign against Hillary Clinton. He was elected over Republican John McCain and assumed office on January 20, 2009. Nine months later, He was named for the 2009 Nobel Peace Prize laureate. After winning reelection by defeating Republican opponent Mitt Romney, Obama was sworn in for a second term in 2013. During his term in office, America's reputation in global polling significantly improved. Obama left office in January 2017 and currently resides in Washington, D.C. A December 2018 Gallup poll found Obama to be the most admired man in America for an unprecedented 11th consecutive year, although Dwight D. Eisenhower was selected most admired in twelve non-consecutive years.
