

Maurice Frederick Strong (29 April 1929 – 27 November 2015) was a Canadian oil and mineral businessman and a diplomat who served as *Under-Secretary-General of the United Nations.* Strong was the President of Power Corporation of Canada until 1966. In the early 1970s he was *Secretary General of the U.N. Conference on the Human Environment*, and then became the first executive director of the U.N. Environment Programme. He headed Ontario Hydro, one of North America's largest power utilities. He served as a commissioner of the World Commission on Environment and Development in 1986 and *was recognised by the International Union for Conservation of Nature as a leader in the international environmental movement*. Strong was an active *Honorary Professor at Peking University and honorary chairman of its Environmental Foundation*. He was chairman of the advisory board for the Institute for Research on Security and Sustainability for Northeast Asia. He died at the age of 86 in 2015.
