Annelies Marie Frank (12 June 1929 – February or March 1945), commonly known as Anne Frank, was a German-born Jewish diarist. One of the most discussed Jewish victims of the Holocaust, she gained fame posthumously with the publication of **The Diary of a Young Girl** (originally Het Achterhuis in Dutch; English: The Secret Annex), in which she documents her life in hiding from 1942 to 1944, during the German occupation of the Netherlands in World War-2. It is one of the world's most widely known books and has been the basis for several plays and films. It was translated from its original Dutch version and first published in English in 1952 as The Diary of a Young Girl, and has since been translated into over 60 languages.
