

John James Audubon (born as Jean Rabin, 26 April 1785 – 27 January 1851) was an American ornithologist, naturalist and painter. He was notable for his extensive studies documenting all types of American birds and for his detailed illustrations that depicted the birds in their natural habitats. His major work, a color-plate book entitled *The Birds of America (1827-39)*, is considered one of the finest ornithological works ever completed. Audubon identified 25 new species.
