Ma Jun, born on 22 May 1968, is a Chinese environmentalist, non-fiction writer, environmental consultant, and journalist. He is a director with the Institute of Public & Environmental Affairs (IPE). Ma became an investigative journalist, working at the South China Morning Post from 1993 to 2000. There, he began to specialize in articles on environmental subjects. Ma's 1999 book on China's Water Crisis has been compared to Rachel Carson's Silent Spring — China's first major book on the subject of that nation's environmental crisis. He directs the IPE, which developed the China Water Pollution Map, the first public database of water pollution information in China. He also serves as environmental consultant for the Sinosphere Corporation. In 2012, Ma received the Goldman Environmental Prize. In 2015, Ma Jun became the first Chinese social entrepreneur who won the Skoll Award.
