Anna Freud (3 December 1895 – 9 October 1982) was an Austrian-British psychoanalyst. She was the sixth and youngest child of Sigmund Freud and Martha Bernays. She followed the path of her father and contributed to the field of psychoanalysis. Alongside Melanie Klein, she may be considered the founder of psychoanalytic child psychology. After the Freud family were forced to leave Vienna for London in 1938 with the advent of the Nazi regime in Austria, she resumed her psychoanalytic practice and her pioneering work in child psychology, establishing the Hampstead Clinic in 1951 (from 1984 the Anna Freud Centre) as a centre of therapy, training and research work. She set up a centre for young war victims, called "The Hampstead War Nursery". Here the children got foster care although mothers were encouraged to visit as often as possible. She was elected as a Foreign Honorary Member of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences in 1959.
