In the first session Dr. Anandi talked about the historical background of Indian educational system, generalized idea and concept of four pillars of Education. She explained in detail regarding the small things to

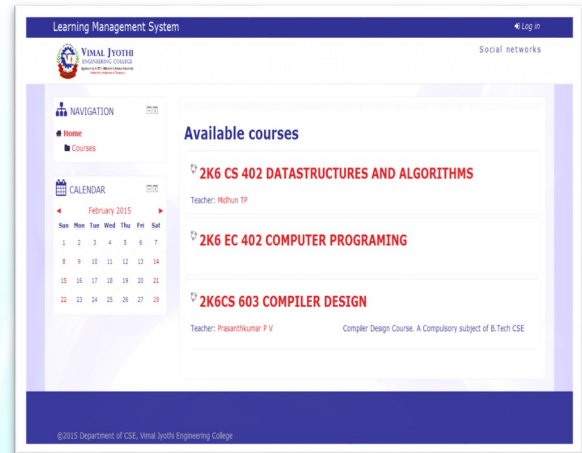

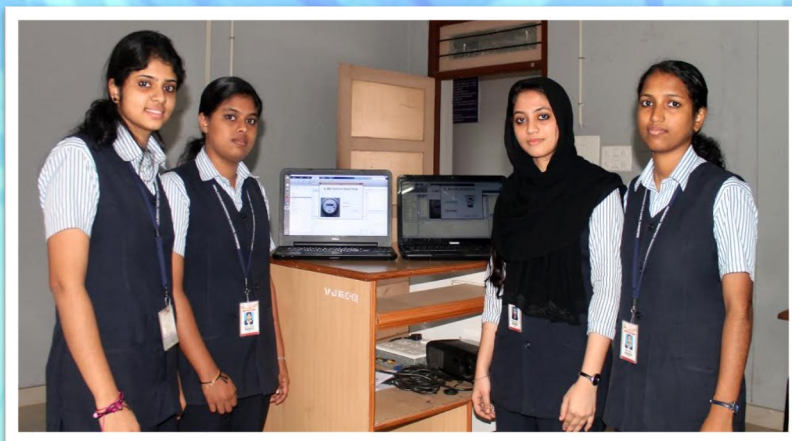
