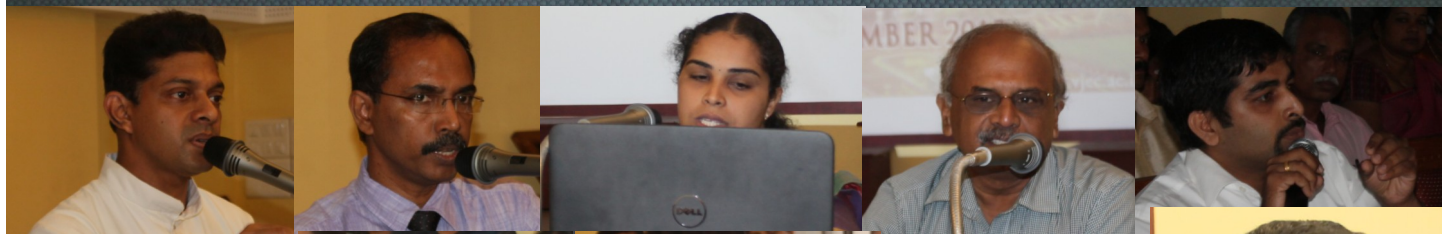
### 3 DAYS WORKSHOP ON INSTRUMENTATION ENGINEERING AND DESIGN

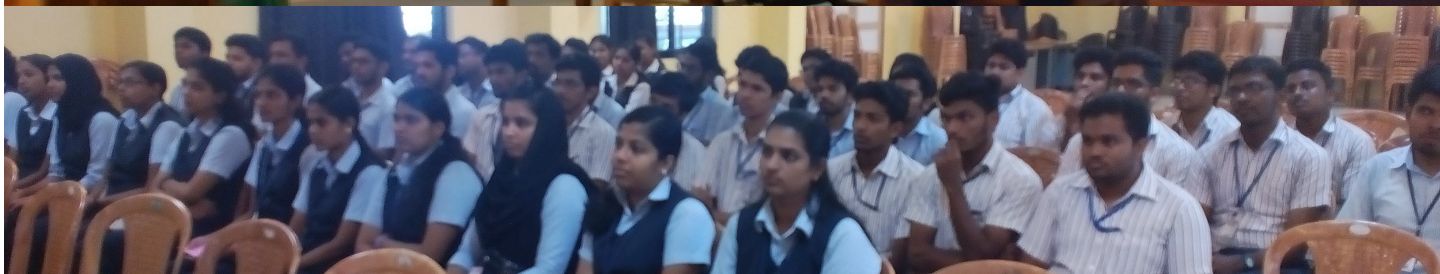
## DEPARTMENT ADVISORY BOARD MEETING ON 6 NOVEMBER 2015
