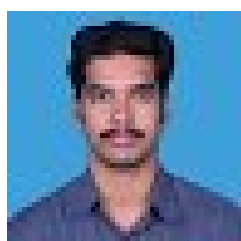
STUDENTS' ACHIEVEMENTS
