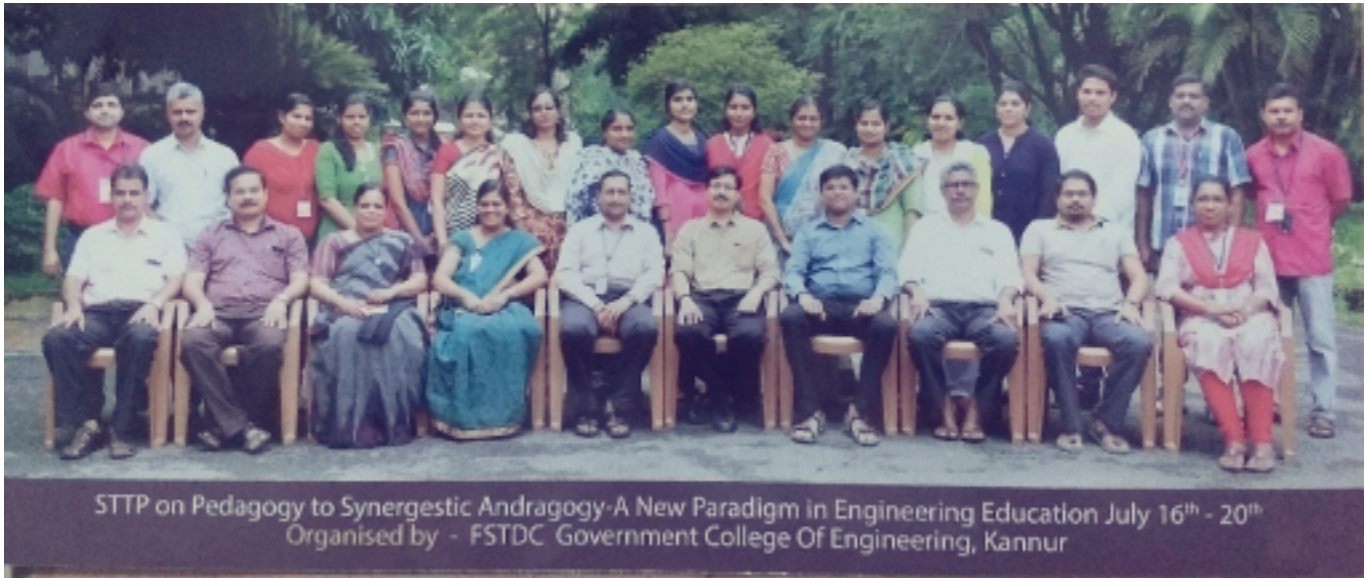
FAREWELL TO AKHIL SIR
